



### <u>Little Wars Convention - General Rules and Policies</u>

### **Attendee Conduct**

Everyone knows that historical miniature gamers are among the most responsible and polite people in the world. But we think it is prudent to remind convention attendees that they are expected to abide by the rules of the convention, as well as any directions given by convention staff and/or the convention site, and, of course, by federal, state and local laws.

### **Convention Badges**

You need an attendee badge! Your badge serves as your ticket of admission to Little Wars, and it is a non-transferable and revocable license. HMGS-Midwest reserves the right to terminate this license at any time, without refund of an attendee's admission, and require that person to leave the premises. No reasons need or may be given.

Convention staff (identified by special "STAFF" badges/shirts) also may deny you entry to the convention area or request that you leave if you are without your badge – so please wear it in a clearly visible place ABOVE your waist during the convention. If you lose your badge, please come to the Registration Desk and after confirmation, we may be able to print a new badge for you.

### Refunds

Due to the high cost of conducting registration for a convention as large as Little Wars, it is not possible for HMGS Midwest staff to issue refunds of any type for any reason without HMGS Midwest Board approval.

### Appropriate Use of Language

We want to remind our attendees that we are in a very public setting that includes families. Please remember to be civil in our interactions and refrain from using vulgar language.

### **Costumes and Weapons**

All costumes that depict aspects or uniforms of the 20th and 21st centuries are prohibited unless prior permission is granted by HMGS-Midwest. The reenactors and living historians invited by the Board have received prior permission to wear and bring their kit for educational purposes. Firearms [gunpowder] from any era, are prohibited, including items for "display" purposes. Attendees are not allowed to carry or display weapons of any type. Active-duty military, police, emergency services, or other similar personnel are exempt from this prohibition when in the act of performing their official duties.

### **Lost or Damaged Materials**

HMGS-Midwest and the Sheraton Hotel assume no responsibility for lost or damaged items or possessions, including, but not limited to, Little Wars badges and gaming items. The registration desk will maintain a lost-and-found department. If you lose any items, please notify registration personnel immediately. Property found on the convention site at the end of the weekend will be returned to the owner if possible, with non-returnable items becoming the property of HMGS-Midwest. HMGS-Midwest strongly encourages you to leave nothing unattended.

### **Little Wars Events Policies**

### A Note to Parents and Guardians

We would like to remind parents and guardians that the safety of their children is their responsibility. You are also responsible for the supervision of all minors, as well as for their behavior at the convention site. Please make certain that minors are appropriately supervised by an adult companion at all times, especially during nighttime hours, when playing in an event, or when back in their hotel rooms.

The venue is responsible for security at their facility (not HMGS-Midwest), and officials from the venue have the right to eject those determined to have caused problems. HMGS-Midwest is not required to offer a refund if your children are removed from the premises. So please, properly supervise minors. They are the future of the hobby. We want them to have an enjoyable – and safe – convention experience.

### **Event Tickets and Registration**

Each event at Little Wars is described on the tabletop events website (see below) including its starting time, location, period of history represented, figure scale and the rules that will be used. All events have Little Wars "Medal of Honor" awards to be given out by the judge. Electronic tickets are used to manage available space in games however all events are FREE!

You may register for as many events as you can play each day. In other words, you are not allowed to register for two simultaneous events. All events are open for registration at any time. You can also return an electronic ticket on tabletop events so that another person can use it to sign up. If you are having trouble registering, please visit the events desk.

### A Badge is Required to Play or Shop

Many people will be roaming through the game hall without badges. The public is invited to see what we are about so they might add to our numbers. Some will have a visitor pass. All Game Judges need to help us make sure that all players have an official badge showing that they have paid for the convention to help HMGS-Midwest cover the costs of playing in this wonderful facility. Those who want to shop and not play may purchase a Shopper's Badge at a reduced price per day.

### **Event Cancellation & Additions**

A white board near the event desk will show added and cancelled events. You can register for added events just as with any scheduled event. Cancelled events will be marked on the board as soon as they are known. If you discover a judge has not shown up for a game that has not yet been cancelled, please contact the events desk. The convention staff has no control over judges actually showing up to run their games. The occasional cancelled game is a risk of playing at cons!

<u>Event Standby – "Alternates"</u>
Judges must first accommodate players holding electronic tickets. Accommodation of additional, non-ticket-holding players (especially beyond the advertised maximum number of players) is at the judge's discretion. Judges are asked to do this on a first-come basis. Judges who allow someone to play without a ticket must ensure that the player has a badge that covers the convention day in question, as everyone else does.

### **Open Gaming**

Did you bring terrain and figures to setup a game at the convention? Would you like to run your already-scheduled event additional times? We may have some space available. Inquire at the events desk. Available space is allocated on a first-come basis.

### Judges and Volunteers – We Need You!

As with any volunteer organization, we live or die by the efforts of our volunteers (judges, desk workers, etc.) Our principal planners donate literally hundreds of hours of their time to planning this convention before it begins. A couple of hours of your time judging or helping attendees while on-site are necessary to help the convention finish well. If you wish to be added to the Judge or Volunteer mailing list for next year, please notify the registration desk.

### **Special Prizes for Judges at Little Wars**

Of course all Judges deserve our thanks for the time and effort put into their wonderful offerings. Two prizes will be awarded this year – Non-historical games are ineligible:

### The Theme Prize - "Fog of War"

Evaluated by a selected panel of judges on how well the subject matter, execution and experience of the game reflect this year's

#### The Best Of Show Presentation – The Duke Seifried Award Prize





## **Little Wars 2022 – Guest of Honor**

## FRANK CHADWICK



Frank founded Game Designers Workshop in 1973 and served as president and chief designer throughout its existence. Frank has also worked as a miniatures rules writer for Old Glory and Wargames Foundry. He has designed over 100 published games (board games, roleplaying, and miniatures rules), written eight novels and about a dozen non-fiction military history books, with the Desert Shield Fact Book reaching number one on the New York Times bestseller list. Frank is currently working on a five-game boardgame project for GMT (Frank Chadwick's ETO), a WW II miniatures rule set for Test of Battle Games (Breakthrough!) and a historical fiction trilogy set in the last decade of Achaemenid Persia (Persian Twilight).

Here is your chance to join Frank and Tom Harris as he tests his newest game "Breakthrough", at Little Wars. This will be a 15mm Operational level game and is still under development.

"Rommel's breakthrough across the Meuse in May of 1940 was one of the decisive battles of World War Two, and is exactly the sort of action BREAKTHROUGH! was designed to recreate on the tabletop. The tank-heavy German panzer divisions with strong air support have to smash through a multi-division French infantry and cavalry force, well-positioned entrenched, but hampered by a sluggish command system. With a deceptively lean game system, players have to play to the particular strengths and weaknesses of the different combat arms."

### **Todd Fisher Award Recipients**

The HMGS-Midwest Todd Fisher Award was established by the Chapter Board in 2011 specifically to provide a means to recognize those individuals that have been instrumental to HMGS-Midwest through distinguished service at its gaming conventions and related events. In keeping with the mission of HMGS-Midwest, individuals may also be recognized for their use of miniature gaming to aid in the teaching of history in an educational setting. It is the hope that award recipients will serve as a source of inspiration to others who might volunteer their time and efforts towards our hobby through HMGS-Midwest. Recommendations for each award category must come from a current member of HMGS Midwest using the procedure noted below.

<u>The Prior Service Award</u> – (Minimum length of service of 3+ years) The recipient would be an individual whose prior service was exemplary and honorable to the HMGS-Midwest organization. (BOD/Staff/Volunteer/GM etc.) A committee consisting of the current Medal Holders would vote on appropriately recommended candidates.

<u>The Active Service Award</u> – (Minimum length of service of 3+ years) The recipient would be an individual whose active service is exemplary to the HMGS-Midwest organization. (BOD/Staff/Volunteer/Educator, etc.) A committee consisting of the current Board of Directors would vote on appropriately recommended candidates. Current Board members are exempt from receiving the award.

<u>The Posthumous Service Award</u> – (Minimum length of service of 3+ years) The recipient would be an individual whose prior works and service are exemplary and honorable to the HMGS-Midwest organization.

(BOD/Staff/Volunteer/GM/Education/Publications/Creations etc). A combined committee consisting of the current Board of Directors and Medal Holders would vote on appropriately recommended candidates.

### **Todd Fisher**

Todd Fisher is recognized as one of the founders of HMGS-Midwest and was the Little Wars Convention Director during its infancy. Serving for 10 years in that position he had to face the rigors of running the convention, snow storms, contracts and cancellations. Most importantly building a solid foundation for others to work with in making the convention what it is today. He served on the HMGS-Midwest BOD for 14 years and on the HMGS-East BOD for 5 years. He was also a prominent figure in the fight against the lead ban aimed at our hobby. This work was successfully concluded when the New York State Health Commission's ban on lead figures was overturned

## The Past Service Award Winner - Harold Johnson

Harold is a wargamer and miniature gamer by choice and has been a part of Midwest wargaming for over 4 decades, but he began like many of us. As a child, Harold began gaming in the 1960's, beginning with favorite strategy games such as Checkers, Backgammon, and Chess taught to him by his uncles and adult family friends. His favorites among popular board games included BATTLESHIP, STRATEGO, RISK, and CIVIL WAR. A member of Chess Club in high school, he participated in the creation of a naval war game on an early plotting computer. He also helped found a Star Trek Fan Club/Science Club, which was really an excuse to play games on a regular basis at the public library. During college at Northwestern University, he was a member of the North Shore General Staff, a frequent player of Fletcher Pratt, Tractics, Wooden Ships and Iron Men, and massive fantasy miniature battles.

Harold also had a passion for conventions, organizing and running his first state convention in Nebraska in 1972. Since then he has volunteered, managed, and grown many game conventions from their nascent years and established industry standards for conventions across the nation. His love of event planning lead to him participate in over 200 conventions locally and internationally as a volunteer, event provider, celebrity, organizer, manager and owner.

In 1986, while attending his first LITTLE WARS™, the HMGS Midwest flagship convention, he was nominated to the Board of Directors by a friend and was elected to serve as the HMGS Midwest President. Harold would go on to serve on the Board of Directors for nearly a decade and a half often as the face of HMGS Midwest.

During his years of service, Harold made many contributions to the support and growth of the HMGS Midwest to become recognized as a major support of the miniature gaming industry for decades. Some of his accomplishments include beginning the first newsletter, helping to select the "Knight" emblem/logo of HMGS, and running the Little Wars convention from 1987 – 1999. Harold also has worked on many other conventions including GEN-CON®, TWIN CON<sup>TM</sup>, GARY CON®, and NEXUS over many decades.

## The Active Service Award Winner – Ray Runge

Ray Runge has been a part of the Midwest gaming scene for many years. Ray first attended Little Wars in 1986 at the Rosemont location and since then he has spent many hours driving to Chicagoland from his home in St Louis. Ray started volunteering at Little Wars helping out with badge registration. He and 3 other friends would come up from St. Louis to specifically work during the day at the registration desk and then GM at night. Over the years under their management the stalwart team ran a smooth and efficient operation.

Ray notes that over the years, he has seen a lot of changes: rules sets come and go but generally improve, the scale of minis changes from 15mm to 25mm and back again, and games have changed for the better....but it is the people that keep him coming back.

Ray continued to volunteer throughout the years and when asked why, he would say, "Because if I can, then I should." Finally it was time to pass the torch, and many of the Grognards relinquished their duties in 2017. Some kept on supporting Little Wars and Ray stands out among many others, still continuously running his games - even running 6 events at last year's Little Wars! One of Ray's favorite memories is the time that he presented an elaborate Pearl Harbor game and no one played because they thought it was a display!

Over the last 36 years, Ray has been a solid contribution to the hobby, the organization, and the Little Wars convention. He has GM'd over 150 events ranging from Starfleet Battles to 15mm fantasy and air games to ships of sail. This year he will be running a modern submarine warfare game of his own design.

Ray certainly deserves this award and our thanks for his long term and continued service.


### The Posthumous Service Award Winner – Neil Zimmerer

Neil was a key figure in Chicago Wargaming for his entire life. He was the creator of many board games, including many best sellers for Avalon Hill. He founded Mayfair games and designed many of their titles.

While his contributions to the hobby in general were massive, in our field he was crucial. Not only did he open his house to gaming every Friday and Saturday night, but allowed it to be used for organizational meetings, including the formation of HMGS-Midwest and the organization of Little Wars. While he never sought to lead, he was always there to facilitate. He ran several departments of Little Wars and put in long hours doing the grunt work before we had organized the volunteer crew. He did most of the design and layout of the program, ran the ticket booth and was the guy who was always there to be called upon when something had to be done, laboring in this role for at least seven years.

Neil was a prolific painter and game master as well. Noteworthy in this regard were his efforts to run games for beginners and youngsters, well before this became a popular thing. He saw that the more advanced rules sets held no attraction for a ten-year-old and yet when they won one of Neil's games, they proudly wore the Little Wars medal. Some of those kids are the young gamers today. Young as in 35-year-olds. Because he never sought the limelight, Neil had not won acclaim until now. Better late than never.
